We understand that work experience is a learning experience and should expand the students understanding of the horticultural industry as well as professional experience..

Whilst on experience students should receive fair breaks and work reasonable hours. Students should not be asked to work beyond the agreed hours.

We commit to accessible work experiences and consider the diverse needs of each student when placing a student. We believe that the students should work in spaces that recognise and support people of all ages, ethnicities, sexual identities and backgrounds.

We believe that our students should receive guidance whilst on experience and that they will be paired with an experienced member of staff that will act as
