Waterloo Millennium Green, Baylis Road, London, SE1 7AA.

Location

Waterloo Millennium Green is an open green space situated at the junction of 2 main roads, Baylis Road and Waterloo Road SE1.

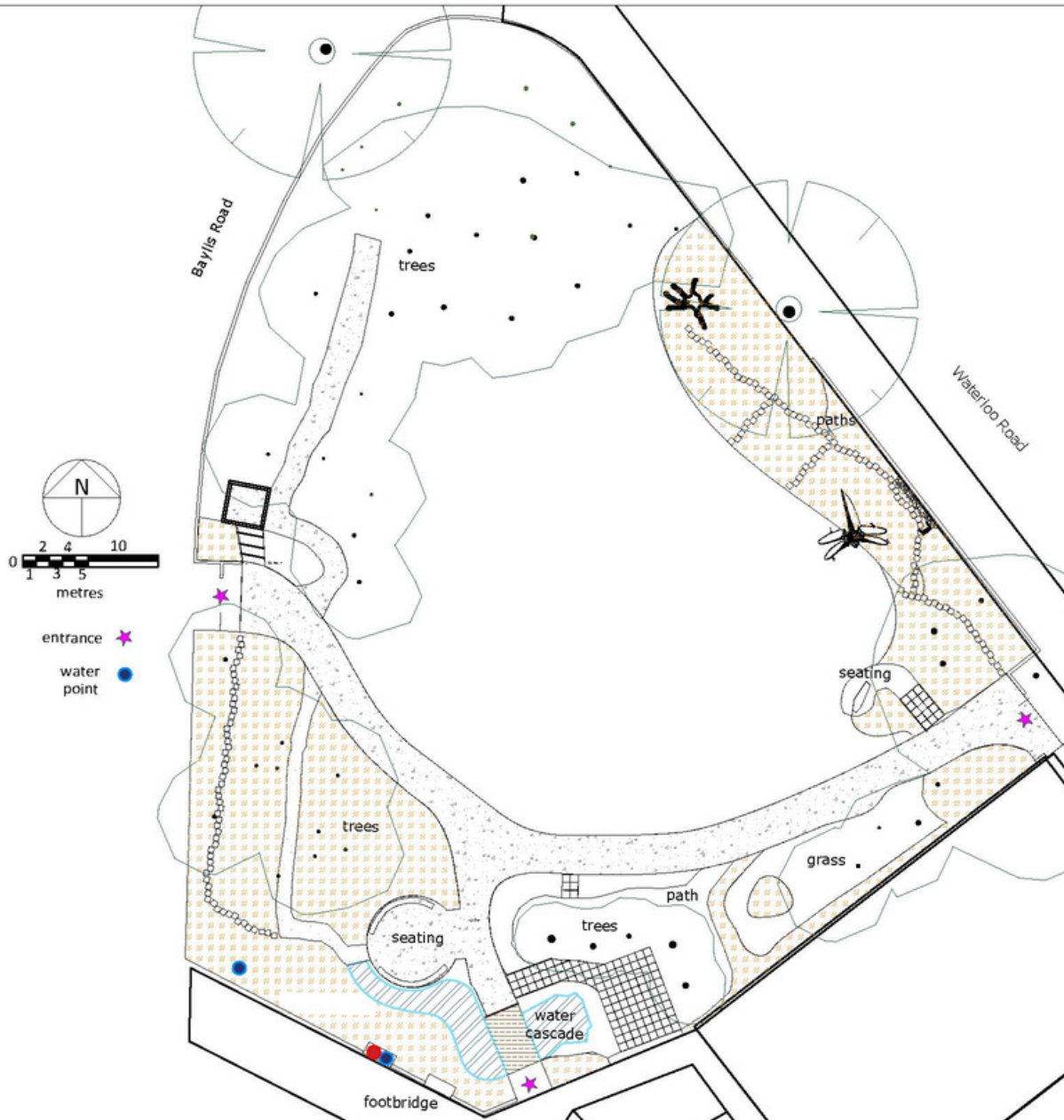
Perfectly located for some of London's major landmarks with Waterloo Rail Station (the busiest train station in the UK) 1 minute away, Lower Marsh Market 1 minute away, Thames Riverside, London Eye and Southbank Cultural quarter a short 5 minute walk. Waterloo Green is also geographically London's most central park.

Description

The space contains a large, open undulating grass area, wide tarmac paths, seating areas, feature planting, public art sculptures, and hard standing spots for food vendors or staging. Water is available on site but electricity needs to be brought in if needed. Low fencing means much of the site is visible from the main roads. The park is particularly busy during the middle of the day as local workers use the site for lunch, and early evening for after work socialising.
